This is the first year we have had a musical for our youngest pupils and the EYFS teams worked tirelessly alongside one of our music teachers Anna-Marie to create an outstanding performance of the musical with our Nursery and Reception pupils.

The children learnt their own lines and all the songs from memory – showing fantastic progress in language and music skills.

What an achievement for our very youngest pupils. We hope this is the first in what will become an annual EYFS tradition for years to come.
