TOWER HAMLETS CRICKET COMPETITION

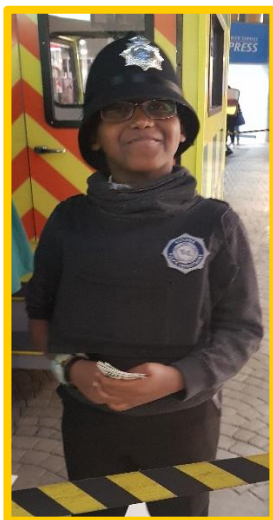
