School closure Monday 23rd March and Free school meals provision

Dear parents and carers,

I am writing to give you the details of what will be happening next week following the school closure on Monday 23 March.

From Monday we will be providing a hot meal every day for all of our pupils in **Reception to Year 6**. The free school meals will be provided every day until the reopening of the school, which I will communicate to you as soon as I am in a position to do so. All of our pupils will be able to collect their free 'Grab and Go lunch' **from 1130 -1315** in the following way:

- **YR - Y1 'Grab and Go lunch' collected from the main hall exit doors next to the administration office entrance doors**
- **Y2- Y6 'Grab and Go lunch' collected from the main school entrance gate**

There will be one lunch per pupil and the food provided will change on a daily basis following a weekly timetable. Arrangements have also been made for the school to be open with a skeleton staff for pupils who are vulnerable and pupils of key workers, as defined by the government. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our staff who have volunteered to come into school every day to support our vulnerable and key worker pupils.

While the school is closed please ensure the pupils complete the physical and digital materials that have been given out today, (arrangements have been made for materials to be collected/distributed to pupils who are already absent). Please also ensure that the pupils continue to get regular exercise, time to interact
