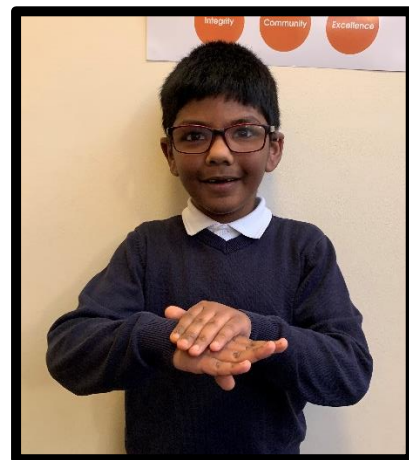
## RED NOSE DAY 2019
