Item	Discussion	Action
1.	<p>Introduction and Apologies:</p> <p>All AC members attended the meeting in person.</p> <p>Jeff Martin (JM, Link Director), Tahreena Ward (TW, Headteacher) and Muhammad Kamaly (MK, Office Manager) were also present.</p>	
2.	<p>Feedback from the last Academy Council meeting:</p> <p>PE Teachers have not been well and so could not come to this meeting.</p> <p>MK has been showing demos for the "my Child at school" app for those parents who have asked at the office. Council members spoke about potentially having this guidance on the website and at the next coffee meeting.</p> <p>TW mentioned that there will be an e-safety event on 7/2/23 and a message will be sent to parents regarding this.</p>	<p>TW will ask PE teachers to come to next meeting</p> <p>MK to demo the app at the coffee meeting next week, have guidance on the website on how to sign up to the app and how to use it, and provide stats of number of sign-ups on the app.</p>
3.	<p>Parent Carer Survey Results:</p> <p>Over 190 parents completed the survey. A letter will be sent out with stats of the results from the survey.</p> <p>TW will be rolling out a new reward scheme for students and that teachers will be expected to give positive reinforcement to students.</p> <p>TW said teachers will be informed to build rapport with parents and be proactive in providing feedback.</p> <p>It was suggested that wider trust achievements being shared to parents may be beneficial.</p> <p>While OFSTED have not visited since 2015 JM said the trust contracts out to a specialist consultancy firm consisting of former senior OFSTED inspectors to inspect the school every year and provide feedback to ensure the school remains outstanding. TW also mentioned that they also inspect each subject area.</p>	

4.	After School Clubs Provision: Positive feedback was given in relation to the after-school clubs provided by the school this term	
5.	Open Forum: Some parents provided feedback to AC members stating that their children felt portion sizes for school meals was not big enough and they felt hungry through the afternoon. MK mentioned that there is always extra food left at the end and so if children wanted more they need to ask the staff. It was mentioned however that the remaining food may not be what the child specifically wants.
