2.	<p>Feedback from the last Academy Council meeting:</p> <p>Tahreena- Text and email set up for Academy council members for important updates.</p>	
3.	<p>Autumn term update:</p> <p>SEND review- 13% of pupils in school have a range of additional needs across the school. 50 pupils with EHCP 30 pupils on SEND support plan. Feedback from review very positive- Pupils are well supported in and out of class.</p> <p>Hinterland- budget constraints - Trust will pay for priority trips however parents will be asked to pay a subsidised contribution. Instalment plans can be arranged for this.</p> <p>School will be holding a number of fundraising events across the school year to raise funds for hinterland visits. School fairs, Easter parade, discos etc. Festival of lights Disco will be held in November to celebrate Diwali, Chinese New Year and bonfire night. Half-moon trips and workshops will be taking place.</p>

National shortage of TODs- However our recruitment is on progress DSP review took place this term- Outcome- teaching and learning very good and high quality.</p>	
<p>5.</p>	<p>Playground arrangements Y1-6 Leadership team is considering having playground zones for different year groups. We have increased the number of staff in the playground. We have a range of playground equipment and games available to pupils at playtime and lunchtime- cricket, basketball, football hula hoops, skipping ropes bridge area, table tennis bikes, football for girls, all on rotation for each year group.</p>	
<p>6.</p>	<p>Open Forum: Fateha Khanom- is there opportunity to provide additional support for pupils who are excelling? (TW) Baselines taken in the first 6 weeks of term to determine support for pupils. Teachers provide challenging work in class. There are opportunities for pupils to join higher read/write groups depending on their level of learning and progress. Jaheda Begum - very happy with communication from the reception teacher this year. Better communication was needed in nursery and feedback and pictures on tapestry. (TW) Tapestry is updated every week to inform parents what children are learning. There are a number of opportunities to speak to teachers to find out what pupils are learning during: Catchup sessions Open classrooms Reading weeks parents meeting Monzo Ara Khatun - Is there additional support for Y6 pupils for SATs? (TW) Morning, afterschool and weekend booster sessions take place for Y6 Pupils. Afters school boosters to start after the October half term. [AC] - Always received good communication from teachers, very pleased with his son's Y2 class teacher who is always willing to take on board his suggestions. [HA] - Daughter is in Y6 and is really happy and enjoying Y6, Class teacher has a good relationship with the pupils and makes the learning fun for the pupils.</p>
