Shared reading: This term we will be reading the following books:

- Peace at Last
- Can't You Sleep Little Bear?
- Six Dinner Sid?
- Tiddler
- The Rainbow Fish
- Handa's Surprise

Phonics: Pupils will have daily speed sounds lessons and then they will be taught how to read and write following our Read Write Inc programme.

Maths: We follow the Mathematics Mastery programme where we will cover the following topics:

- Representing, comparing and exploring numbers within 10
- Finding one more and one less
- Doubling and halving

Science: This term we will be learning about plants and the seasons.

Humanities: History - We will be learning about childhood and how this has changed over time. Pupils will also go on an educational visit to the V&A Childhood museum.

Computing: Pupils will be learning to log on with their unique logins and passwords as well as simple programming using Bee-Bots.

PSHE: The year will begin with pupils getting to know each other and the year 1 staff. Following the first two units of the Jigsaw programme, we will cover 'Being Me' and 'Celebrating Differences'.

Music: Our specialist music teachers will be teaching music lessons across the school this year. The year 1 music teacher will be Karen.

P.E: This half term PE shall be taught every **Monday**. Pupils will change into their PE kit in school. Please ensure your child has appropriate footwear and kit.

Homework: Homework will be given out every Friday and this is expected to be completed by the following Wednesday. It is expected that your child reads for 15 minutes every day and that their reading record is **signed and dated** everyday by an adult.

Book change: Pupils need to bring in their books on Wednesdays and Fridays as those are the days we change our books.
