The pupils have also been thoroughly enjoying their **Reading for Pleasure** sessions in the library.



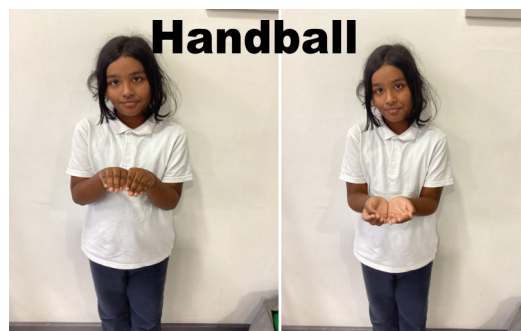
