In our talk through stories sessions, the children have started reading 'Meet the Planets', 'Hello star' and will continue reading space themed books. The children have done a fantastic job practising their number bonds to 10 using number frames as well as doubling and halving! Some of our children have been practising matching and identifying numbers between 1-5 and 1-10, they have also practised identifying doubles up to 5 aswell as halves. During week 1, our focus topic was based Guy Fawkes. The children really enjoyed completing various activities from printing fireworks to using drawing fireworks using our scratch paper!
