Year 4 Curriculum for Spring 2

Class: Year 4 - Shah, Chloe and Aklima's Classes

Shared reading: This half term we are reading Malamander, by Thomas Taylor. Each lesson we look at new vocabulary, read several pages of the book together as a class and answer comprehension and inference style questions associated with the text.

Writing: This term we will have a focus on different styles of writing in our Literacy and Language lessons. The pupils will study a range of text types including setting descriptions and diary entries, and create their own writing outcomes based on last half term's shared reading book, Matilda

Maths: This term, we are continuing our focus on the multiplication times table check (MTC)- please continue using TTRS or paper based sheets to practice with your child. During maths lessons, we shall begin by continuing our work on fractions before moving onto time. We will then move on to learn about decimals, and area and perimeter.

Science: We shall be learning about plants. We will also be basing some non-fiction writing around this topic.

Humanities: This half term we have a focus on History, with the topic being Anglo Saxons. Pupils will learn about Anglo Saxon power and how they were eventually overthrown. We will also be basing some non-fiction writing around some of these topics.

Computing: The children will learn about data logging with their specialist computing teacher, Paul.

Spanish: We have a specialist language teacher, Maggie Allen, who will be teaching Spanish language.

PSHE: Our topic this half term is 'Healthy Me,' where we will look at healthy friendships and lifestyles.

Music: Specialist music teachers (Carys and Karen) will teach the pupils Music at various times throughout the week.

P.E.: For this half term, PE stays the same as Spring 1.

4C & 4E (Shah/Aklima) have PE every Friday morning in school. Pupils are reminded that they can come into school in their PE kits, but must bring their uniform to change back into.

4I (Chloe) has PE in school on a Wednesday afternoon. Pupils are reminded that they must come into school wearing uniform, and to bring their PE kit in a bag to change into.

Homework: Homework will be given online via google classroom every Friday and is expected to be returned by the following Wednesday. If your child needs support with their homework from their teacher, they can bring their homework to show them Monday-Wednesday. Please remind pupils to use their homework books to complete homework if you are unable to submit online.

Pupils **must read everyday for a minimum of 15 minutes** with a signature from an adult in their Reading Record.

Reading Plus: Children will be completing one hour per week of Reading Plus. This is an online resource which helps to monitor and challenge children to develop their reading and vocabulary skills.
