Home Connection: The "Kindness Toothpaste" Activity



To understand why **kindness** is important, squirt a small tube of toothpaste onto a plate with your child. Next, challenge them to use a spoon or toothpick to put it all back inside the tube. When they realize it is impossible, explain that our words are just like toothpaste: once they leave our mouths, we can never pull them back in. It is a fun, memorable way to show children the power of their words and why choosing kindness matters!
