Summer in Nursery!

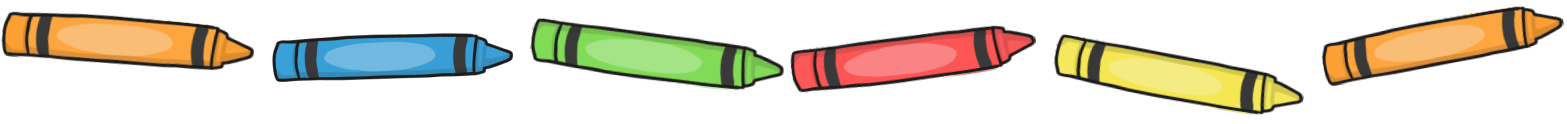
Summer 1 has been another absolutely wonderful term in Nursery, and the children have thrown themselves into our learning with so much energy!
