Our topic this half term is '**Journeys and Holidays**'. Pupils will gain an understanding of the various forms of transport, destinations and preparation needed to go on a journey or holiday as well as;

Oral shared reading: We shall be reading a range of texts this half term, including 'The Day the Crayons Came Home', 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Snail and the Whale', 'My Three Best Friends and me, Zulay', 'Transport', 'Everything Space', 'The Everywhere Bear', and more.

Maths: We shall be learning: the different ways of making 6 & 7, exploring how to make 8&9, begin counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and explore number patterns within 10.

Music: Pupils will be encouraged to sing and create music based upon the theme of **Journeys and Holidays**.



P.E.: This half term PE shall be taught every **Monday**.
