

## **RE: Warm Weather Adjustments, Uniform, and Fan Policy Reminders**

With the arrival of the warmer weather, we want to ensure that all of our pupils remain safe, comfortable, and able to learn effectively. **Please note that the school will remain open** as we have put several reasonable adjustments in place to keep our children cool.

To ensure the comfort and well-being of our pupils during extreme heat, the school is implementing the following temporary measures:

- **Temperature Monitoring:** Classroom temperatures will be closely monitored throughout the day. While we intend to remain open, **the school will consider an early closure if deemed necessary** for safety. We will update you immediately should this happen.
- **Air-Conditioned Access:** All children will have scheduled access to an air-conditioned room throughout the day to cool down.
- **Reduced Physical Activity:** Strenuous physical activities and PE lessons will be significantly scaled back or moved indoors/to shaded areas.
- **Flexible Timetable:** We will be running a modified, lower-energy timetable where necessary to keep children out of the midday heat.

Please ensure your child is dressed according to our summer uniform guidelines:

- **Girls:** Can wear a blue gingham summer dress or shorts and a white t-shirt.
- **Boys:** Can wear shorts and a white t-shirt.
- **Fan Policy Note:** While we want children to stay cool, please note that **electronic fans** (including handheld, battery-operated, or USB fans) **are not allowed** in school due to classroom distractions and safety hazards. Children are, however, very welcome to bring a **manual, folding hand fan**.
- **Suncream:** Please apply high-factor suncream to your child before school.
- **Water Bottles:** Ensure your child has a reusable water bottle.
- **Hats:** Please send your child with a sun hat or cap to wear during break times.
