Our topic this half term is 'Marvellous Me'.

Oral shared reading: We shall be reading a range of text this half term, books include 'Mr Big', 'My senses', 'We're going on a bear hunt', 'The Gruffalo', 'Where's my teddy?' and 'The Gruffalo's child'.

Maths: We shall be teaching classifying, matching, comparing and ordering, Patterns and numbers within 20.



Music: Music will be cross curricular and will be incorporated into all lessons where possible. Pupils shall learn new songs and have opportunities to play musical instruments.

P.E.: This half term PE shall be taught every **Monday**. They will learn about spacial awareness, moving around the hall safely and the importance of keeping fit and staying healthy. **Please ensure your child is sent to school dressed in their PE kit (white t-shirt, dark shorts/leggings/tracksuit bottoms and plimsolls).** Please bring pupils school uniforms in their bag as we will be practising changing into their uniform for pupils gross motor skills.

Homework: Maths or English will be given out every Friday and should be returned by Thursday.
